- ✓ **In Compliance with OSHA 1910.22 & 1910.176**

- ✓ **1910.22(a)(1)**
All places of employment, passageways, storerooms, service rooms and walking-working surfaces are kept in a clean, orderly, and sanitary condition.

(a)(3) Walking-working surfaces are maintained free of hazards such as sharp or protruding objects, loose boards, corrosion, leaks, spills, snow, and ice.



- ✓ **1910.176(c)**
Housekeeping. Storage areas shall be kept free from accumulation of materials that constitute hazards from tripping, fire, explosion or pest harborage. Vegetation control will be exercised when necessary.
