1910.1200 Hazard Communication GHS Compliance



Secondary containers are a frequently cited OSHA violation

- ✓ Ensure all secondary containers that are not used immediately are labeled with Proper GHS Complaint Label
- ✓ It is not acceptable to write the product name with a sharpie
- ✓ Food and Beverage containers are not to be used as secondary containers
- ✓ Ensure all chemical containers have the 6 elements listed below

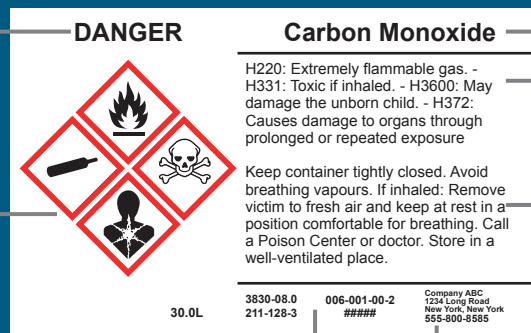
GHS Label Elements

1. Signal Word:

Indicates relative level of hazard. 'Danger' is used for most severe instances, while "Warning" is less severe.

2. Symbols (Hazard Pictograms):

Convey health, physical and environmental hazard information with red diamond pictograms. May use a combination of one to five symbols.



3. Product Name or Identifiers*

4. Hazard Statements:

Phrases that describe the nature of hazardous products and often times the degree of hazard.

5. Precautionary Statements:

Phrases associated with each hazard statement, that describe general preventative, response, storage or disposal precautions.

*Additional Product Identifiers

Company name, address & telephone number.
