FMCSA ELD Exemption

Exclusive for NWRA

Considering the benefits that NWRA's safety and education programs have for the Association's members, the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) decided to exclusively offer Electronic Logging Device (ELD) exemptions for waste collection vehicles to NWRA members.

FMCSA Electronic Logging Device Exemption

FMCSA has granted NWRA a rare Hours-of-Service exemption exclusively to its members, eliminating the need for them to purchase and use ELDs as otherwise is required under the new rule. NWRA submitted its exemption request on behalf of the entire waste and recycling industry, but FMCSA narrowed the scope to just NWRA members.
