TIPS FOR WINTER WEATHER DRIVING



- ✓ Reduce your speed on icy and snow packed roads
- ✓ Allow additional room for braking
- ✓ Increase your following distance
- ✓ Slow down on turns, curves and ramps
- ✓ Keep your windows, mirrors and lights free from snow and ice build up
- ✓ Keep a brush and scraper in your vehicle to address any snow and ice buildup during your shift that may impair your visibility
- ✓ Turn on your headlights for better visibility for you and other motorists
- ✓ Clear snow from the top of your vehicle, many states have laws requiring this
- ✓ Overpasses and bridges freeze sooner than normal road surfaces
- ✓ Be on the lookout for black ice, as it may appear as a wet road surface
- ✓ Top off your windshield washer fluid and make sure your wipers are working properly
