







LOTOTO LOCKOUT/TAGOUT/TRYOUT

Many remember Lockout/Tagout, but fail to remember the third step, Tryout.

Main Points

1. Purpose of Tryout:

Tryout verifies that equipment is properly locked out and safe to operate. It prevents accidents and injuries caused by accidental startups.

2. Safeguards Are Not Foolproof:

Safeguards like proxy switches and motion sensors may fail or be bypassed. They should never be relied upon solely for safety.

3. Proper Tryout Procedure:

- Ensure Proper Lockout/Tagout: Confirm all energy sources are isolated and lockout/tagout devices are securely in place.
- Visual Inspection: Check for any signs of damage or tampering.
- ✓ Test the Equipment: Attempt to start it to confirm it remains inoperable.
- Seek Assistance: Notify supervisor or safety personnel if any issues or unexpected behavior is encountered.
