




Lithium batteries are deadly if not disposed of properly.



 Lithium batteries cannot be processed through normal waste streams and should never be placed inside regular waste or recycling containers.





 These batteries pose a risk of a fire throughout the waste disposal process, including during waste truck transportation to recycling facilities and landfills.



 Lithium batteries should only be disposed of only at facilities qualified to accept them.
