

Construction & Demolition Recycling Facility of the Year Award Application

This award is open to construction and demolition (C&D) recycling facilities owned/operated by either NWRA members or public sector/non-profit entities that have embraced waste prevention and effective use, reuse, or recovery of resources. The award is intended to recognize a facility as a model for C&D waste diversion, as well as for instilling a culture of waste prevention and sustainable debris management among employees.

Applicants are asked to describe methodologies and provide data to quantify the impact of their efforts.

Application Fee: \$150

How to Enter:

NWRA will prepare and send an invoice to you. The invoice MUST be paid by the awards application deadline of July 31 for your application to be considered.

Application Guidelines:

Your application for C&D Recycling Facility of the Year should provide the information necessary for NWRA's Recycling Committee and awards judges to understand how the nominated facility and related program improves recycling, recovery, and reuse of C&D materials.

1) Applicant Information:

- The name of the facility.
- Contact information (name, email, phone number) of the person responsible for answering all questions about the application and for payment of the application fee.
- Identify whether the nomination is being submitted by 1) an NWRA member or 2) a public sector/non-profit entity that is not eligible for NWRA membership.
- A list of people (with titles and companies) responsible for the nominated facility.
- A logo for each of the identified companies or organizations.

2) Qualifying Criteria:

NWRA's Recycling Committee and awards judges will evaluate award applications based on the effect of the nominated Construction & Demolition Recycling Facility on area recycling and recovery.

- **Program background and goals – 40 points:** Provide a narrative about the facility's history and background. Include details about siting; design; size, equipment, and capacity of the original facility. Discuss the facility's goals and the materials accepted. Describe any major barriers to success that were resolved.
- **Program effectiveness and metrics – 45 points:** Identify sustainability measures – both qualitative and quantitative – and how the candidate facility works to achieve them. Provide and explain measurable results. Data can be presented in the narrative or through charts and graphs. A picture is worth a thousand words. Please include color photographs, drawings, or schematics that illustrate your innovation and accomplishment.
- **Additional information and recognition – 10 points:** Include additional information including letters of recommendation, copies of brochures and print ads, links to videos, etc. Discuss any awards, honors, or recognition already received.
- **Application quality – 5 points**

Submission Format Options

All applications must be completed using the Jotform application. Applicants will be asked to select one of the following two methods to provide their responses to the **Qualifying Criteria**:

- **Upload a complete submission** as a single PDF that includes all required responses to the *Qualifying Criteria* section, along with any photos, figures, or attachments. The entire file must not exceed 20 pages.
- **Complete the application through the form** by filling in the provided fields and uploading supporting materials where prompted. A compiled PDF will be generated upon submission and must also not exceed 20 pages in total length.

Please note submissions that exceed the 20-page limit may be disqualified.

The application fee must be paid by the July 31 application deadline for the nomination to be considered.

 - You will be directed to the final Confirmation and Submission section
- **Option B:** Complete this form to provide your responses and upload supporting materials as prompted. (Must not exceed 20 pages total)

The following sections (5–7) are only required for applicants who choose Option B.

Section 5: Program Background and Goals

Upload or enter a narrative covering the facility's history, siting, design, size, equipment, accepted materials, and goals. Describe major barriers to success and how they were overcome. (PDF, DOC or enter text)

Section 6: Program Effectiveness and Metrics

- Share quantitative and qualitative sustainability data
- Upload documents or visuals like charts, graphs, visuals (e.g., photos or schematics) to support measurable results (PDF, JPG, PNG or DOC) — multiple files allowed

Section 7: Additional Information and Recognition

- Upload letters of recommendation (PDF, DOC) — multiple files allowed
- Upload brochures or print ads (PDF, PNG, JPG) — multiple files allowed
- Provide links to social media posts, videos, or websites
- Describe any awards, honors, or recognition received

Section 8: Confirmation and Submission

- Confirm that all information is accurate and complete
- Signature

NWRA will celebrate all Recycling Awards winners in person during the NWRA Industry Conference being held January 18-20, 2027, in Nashville, Tennessee.
