



NWRA Hall of Fame Nomination – Required Information Guide

This guide lists all of the required information and questions you will need to complete the National Waste & Recycling Association (NWRA) Hall of Fame Nomination Form. We recommend reviewing this document and preparing your responses before starting the online form.

Part 1: Nominee Information

- Full Name
- Nominee Status (Working / Retired / Deceased)
- Job Title
- Current/Most Recent Employer
Note: Employer to be recognized as part of the nomination.
- Email Address
- Telephone Number
- Address
- Upload at least one high-resolution headshot photo (no group shots)

Part 2: Nominee's Qualifying Criteria

Option to upload a Word or PDF with your written responses OR type directly in the form.

1. How is the nominee recognized within the industry (founder, pioneer, visionary, icon)?
2. Detail the enduring legacy and impact of contributions (25+ years). Including when the nominee worked for a member company of the National Waste and Recycling Association and validate that the candidate has at least 25 years of service in the industry.
3. Characterize the nominee's values (integrity, respect, courage, mentorship, volunteerism, inclusiveness).
4. Describe how the Nominee has demonstrated inspirational leadership as an NWRA service provider or supplier and on issues important to NWRA at the national, state and/or local level.
5. Specify active NWRA engagement and service by the Nominee as an ambassador of the industry through involvement with the association and/or NWRA's chapters.

Part 3: Letters of Recommendation (5 required)

For each of the five recommenders, provide:

- Recommender's Name
- Recommender's Job Title and Company Name
- Indicate if they are a current NWRA Hall of Fame Member
- Upload their letter of recommendation (Word or PDF)

*Each individual may submit only **one** letter of recommendation per application year.*

Note on Letters of Recommendation:

It is the nominator's responsibility to inform each recommender of this policy and confirm that they have not already submitted a letter for another applicant. Additionally, [Hall of Fame Committee members](#) cannot provide recommendation letters.
